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Course Description:

This course is a study of the use of a variety of media such as paper, fibers, glass, clay and metal for wearable art. A variety of techniques will be explored while stressing craftsmanship and personal creativity.

Semesters: 2 Credits: 1 Prerequisite: Art 1

Grading:

The expectations for each project will be clearly stated and posted at the beginning of each assignment. Students will be graded on the basis of their completion of the success criteria. Final Projects=60% Daily work= 40%,

Materials:

Each student will be charged a supply fee for this class. The fee will cover most of the materials that the student will need for this class. Additional materials and equipment will be supplied by the school. Occasionally a student may be asked to bring in additional supplies-these will either be minimal cost or optional.

Subject Matter:

The guidelines for appropriate subject matter for art projects is the same as those for what is appropriate on clothing. In other words, if it is not appropriate on clothing, it is not acceptable on art work. Copyrighted imagery may not be used in the creation of any artwork in this class.
